Introduction of Bills

Reps. Espinoza and Mayes introduced

House Bill No. 6567, entitled

A bill to amend 1965 PA 203, entitled "Commission on law enforcement standards act," by amending section 9 (MCL 28.609), as amended by 2005 PA 239.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Homeland Security.

Rep. Espinoza introduced

House Bill No. 6568, entitled

A bill to require persons convicted of child abuse offenses to register; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain departments and agencies in connection with that registration; and to prescribe fees, penalties, and sanctions.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Rep. Espinoza introduced

House Bill No. 6569, entitled

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 11b of chapter XVII (MCL 777.11b), as amended by 2008 PA 538.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Reps. Lisa Brown and Gonzales introduced

House Bill No. 6570, entitled

A bill to require the department of energy, labor, and economic growth to conduct a study concerning low-carbon fuel standards, renewable fuels, vehicle electrification, and related subjects; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Great Lakes and Environment.

Reps. Haines, Genetski, Rogers and Agema introduced

House Bill No. 6571, entitled

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," (MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 700.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to provide for the exemption of certain property from certain taxes; to levy and collect a specific tax upon the owners of certain property; to provide for the disposition of the tax; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain local government officials; and to provide penalties.

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," by amending section 4a (MCL 205.54a), as amended by 2008 PA 415.
