House Bill No. 5072, entitled

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 20155 (MCL 333.20155), as amended by 2001 PA 218.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Senior Health, Security, and Retirement.

Reps. Williams, Phillips, Gonzales and Alma Smith introduced

House Bill No. 5073, entitled

A bill to protect and promote the health and welfare of infants; to provide for training of certain individuals regarding infant safety; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and agencies.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

Reps. Williams, Phillips, Gonzales and Alma Smith introduced

House Bill No. 5074, entitled

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 74103a.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 228, entitled "Single business tax act," by amending section 31 (MCL 208.31), as amended by 1999 PA 115.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

Rep. Stakoe introduced

House Bill No. 5077, entitled

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 7453 (MCL 333.7453), as added by 1988 PA 139; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Rep. Vagnozzi introduced

House Bill No. 5078, entitled

A bill to amend 1911 PA 149, entitled "An act to provide for the acquisition by purchase, condemnation and otherwise by state agencies and public corporations of private property for the use or benefit of the public, and to define the terms "public corporations," "state agencies" and "private property" as used herein," by amending section 3 (MCL 213.23).

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

Rep. Bieda introduced

House Bill No. 5079, entitled

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act," by amending section 26 (MCL 169.226), as amended by 2001 PA 250.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

Rep. Bieda introduced

House Bill No. 5080, entitled

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act," by amending section 24 (MCL 169.224), as amended by 1999 PA 237.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.
