SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 370

A bill to establish the pediatric congenital heart association fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "pediatric congenital heart association fund act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- 5 (b) "Fund" means the pediatric congenital heart association6 fund created in section 5.
- 7 Sec. 5. (1) The pediatric congenital heart association fund is 8 created in the department to provide funds for donation to the





- 1 Michigan chapter of the Pediatric Congenital Heart Association. The
- 2 department shall be the administrator of the fund for auditing
- 3 purposes.
- 4 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 5 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 6 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other
- 7 source for deposit into the fund.
- 8 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- 9 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 10 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 11 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 12 investment of that money, and money from any other source.
- 13 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
- 14 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- Sec. 7. The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall be
- 16 expended solely for donation to the Michigan chapter of the
- 17 Pediatric Congenital Heart Association to support the Michigan
- 18 chapter of the Pediatric Congenital Heart Association in improving
- 19 the lives of those with congenital heart disease and their families
- 20 through direct support, education, research, and awareness.
- 21 Sec. 9. The money in the fund that is available for
- 22 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money granted or
- 23 received as a gift or donation to the fund is available for
- 24 distribution upon appropriation.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 26 Senate Bill No. 371 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
