

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5488**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending sections 16317, 16343, and 18201 (MCL 333.16317,
333.16343, and 333.18201), section 16317 as added by 1993 PA 80 and
section 16343 as added by 1993 PA 79, and by adding section 18211a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 16317. (1) ~~At~~**Except as otherwise provided in section**
2 **16343, at** the beginning of each state fiscal year, the department
3 may increase the fees collected under sections 16319 to 16349 by a
4 percentage amount equal to not more than the average percentage
5 wage and salary increase granted for that fiscal year to classified
6 civil service employees employed by the department.

7 (2) If the department increases fees under subsection (1), the



1 increase ~~shall be~~ **is** effective for that fiscal year. The **department**
2 **shall use the** increased fees ~~shall be used by the department~~ as the
3 basis for calculating fee increases in subsequent fiscal years.

4 (3) By August 1 of each year the department shall provide to
5 the director of the department of management and budget and the
6 chairpersons of the appropriations committees of the senate and
7 house of representatives a complete schedule of fees to be
8 collected under sections 16319 to 16349 for the following fiscal
9 year.

10 Sec. 16343. **(1)** Fees for a person licensed or seeking
11 licensure to engage in the practice of psychology under part 182
12 are as follows:

- 13 (a) Application processing fee..... \$ 50.00
- 14 (b) License fee, per year:

 - 15 (i) Full doctoral..... 90.00
 - 16 (ii) Limited doctoral..... 30.00
 - 17 (iii) Masters limited..... 60.00
 - 18 (iv) Temporary limited..... 15.00

- 19 (c) Limited license, per year..... 40.00
- 20 (d) Temporary license..... 15.00
- 21 (e) Examination review fee..... 20.00

22 **(2) At the beginning of each state fiscal year, the department**
23 **may increase the fees collected under this section by an amount no**
24 **greater than the psychology interjurisdictional compact renewal**
25 **amount to reasonably enforce the psychology interjurisdictional**
26 **compact, to implement the psychology interjurisdictional compact,**
27 **to pay a fee imposed by the psychology interjurisdictional compact**
28 **commission, or to implement a needed change to an information**
29 **technology system because of this state's membership in the**



1 psychology interjurisdictional compact.

2 (3) If the department increases fees under subsection (2), the
3 increase is effective for that fiscal year and the increase applies
4 only to those participating in the psychology interjurisdictional
5 compact. The department shall use the increased fees as a basis for
6 calculating fee increases in subsequent fiscal years.

7 (4) As used in this section, "psychology interjurisdictional
8 compact" means the psychology interjurisdictional compact as
9 enacted in section 16190.

10 Sec. 18201. (1) As used in this part:

11 (a) "Psychologist" means an individual **who is** licensed **or**
12 **authorized** under this article to engage in the practice of
13 psychology.

14 (b) "Practice of psychology" means the rendering to
15 individuals, groups, organizations, or the public of services
16 involving the application of principles, methods, and procedures of
17 understanding, predicting, and influencing behavior for the
18 purposes of the diagnosis, assessment related to diagnosis,
19 prevention, amelioration, or treatment of mental or emotional
20 disorders, disabilities or behavioral adjustment problems by means
21 of psychotherapy, counseling, behavior modification, hypnosis,
22 biofeedback techniques, psychological tests, or other verbal or
23 behavioral means. The practice of psychology ~~shall~~**does** not include
24 the practice of medicine such as prescribing drugs, performing
25 surgery, or administering electro-convulsive therapy.

26 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
27 contains general definitions and principles of construction
28 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
29 definitions applicable to this part.



1 Sec. 18211a. (1) A psychologist who has temporary
2 authorization to practice under the psychology interjurisdictional
3 compact or is authorized to practice interjurisdictional
4 telepsychology under the psychology interjurisdictional compact is
5 authorized to engage in the practice of psychology under this
6 article.

7 (2) For purposes of this article, including the obligations of
8 an individual who is licensed as a psychologist under this part, a
9 psychologist who has temporary authorization to practice under the
10 psychology interjurisdictional compact or is authorized to practice
11 interjurisdictional telepsychology under the psychology
12 interjurisdictional compact is considered a psychologist who is
13 licensed under this part.

14 (3) As used in this section, "psychology interjurisdictional
15 compact" means the psychology interjurisdictional compact as
16 enacted in section 16190.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
18 unless House Bill No. 5489 of the 101st Legislature is enacted into
19 law.
