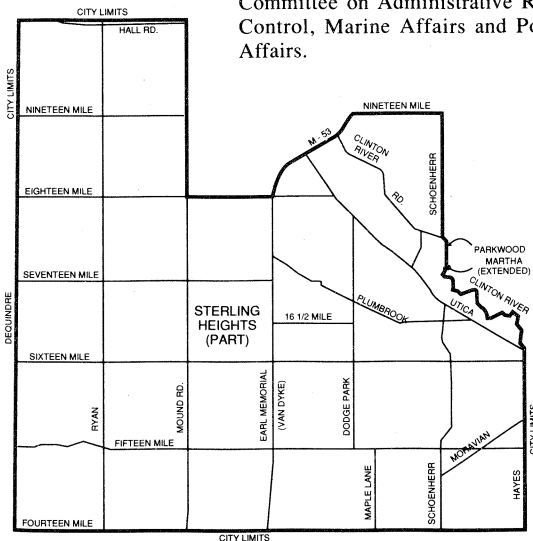

S.; when he was 13, the Roccas immigrated to the United States, setting up residency in Detroit; attended St. Ambrose Catholic School, Jackson Junior High, and Southeastern High School in Detroit; industrial technology program at Cass Tech and Macomb County Community College; graduate, Real Estate Institute (G.R.I. certificate), University of Michigan; in 1968, moved to Warren, and then in 1972, to Sterling Heights. His employment record is as diverse as his background, working as a fruit and vegetable peddler at the young age of seven, having his own sales business at 13, and working as a journeyman skilled tradesman for General Motors after high school graduation; currently a licensed real estate broker in Michigan, but on inactive status in order to devote full time and energy to duties and responsibilities in the Michigan Legislature; married to the former Suzanne J. Marshall; two children, Michael Christopher Rocca and Tory Matthew Rocca; parishioner at St. Blase Catholic Church, Sterling Heights; member, Macomb County Association for Retarded Citizens, Detroit Institute of Arts, United Auto Workers, Keep Michigan Beautiful, Sterling Heights Garden Club, Recreation Vehicle United Citizens Association, National Rifle Association, Vietnam Veterans of America; first elected to the House of Representatives, 1974; majority vice chair of the House Committee on Public Health; member, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and House Committees on Liquor Control, Marine Affairs and Port Development, Insurance, and State Affairs.
