²The decennial reapportionment of Michigan House of Representative districts was approved May 21, 1982. Implementation of the reapportionment plan resulted in a change in the district number of eighteen representatives (Brotherton, Ciaramitaro, DeBeaussert, Evans, Fitzpatrick, Gilmer, Kilpatrick, Mahalek, McNamee, McNeely, Muxlow, Padden, Scott, S. Stopczynski, Strand, Trim, Van Singel, Watkins) whose service spanned that period. Those changes became effective for the November 1982 election. These representatives are listed with both the old and new district numbers and their period of service to each.
