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***ADDENDUM TO SENATE FISCAL  
AGENCY ANALYSIS OF SENATE BILL  
393 OF 9-12-89***

The House Public Health Committee adopted several amendments to the Senate-passed version of Senate Bill 393, including the following.

- The bill would take effect 30 days after enactment rather than October 1, 1989.
- The Senate-passed bill says the maximum annual debt or expense repayment to a participating health provider would be \$25,000 per year in the first year of the program and that figure "shall" be increased by five percent each succeeding year. The House committee amendment says the repayment maximum "may" be increased.
- An amendment not related to the health care provider recruitment program would delay the implementation of the new licensing act for counselors from January 1, 1990, to October 1, 1990, and change two other dates accordingly.
