AN ADDENDUM TO THE SENATE FISCAL AGENCY ANALYSIS OF SENATE BILL 971 AS PASSED BY THE SENATE

House Insurance Committee adopted Substitute H-1 for Senate Bill 971, which would require the consent of the insured before an employer could insure the lives of its directors, officers, and managers. The bill as passed the Senate already required the consent of other employees and retirees before a company could insure their lives.
