A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4908 AS INTRODUCED 6-8-89

One of the earliest pieces of AIDS-related legislation in Michigan, Public Act 258 of 1987 (Senate Bill 544) established a Michigan Health Initiative Fund (financed by a sales tax on computer software) that funds, among other things, local community demonstration and pilot projects on the care of AIDS patients. The bill would amend the Public Health Code to prohibit the Department of Public Health from awarding grants from the Michigan Health Initiative Fund to a local community demonstration and pilot project that provided service in a facility within 5,000 feet of a residential area.
