A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5062 AS INTRODUCED 9-21-89

The bill would create a new act which would require the labeling of any milk products from cows that had been treated with the growth hormone called bovine somatotropin (BST). The bill also would impose a civil fine of at least \$5,000 for each violation, and would allow the Department of Agriculture to confiscate and destroy any milk products not labeled as required.
