A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5377 AS INTRODUCED 12-13-90

The bill would amend the Michigan Penal Code to establish special criminal penalties for people who take shopping carts, milk crates, and similar items without written permission. For the penalties to apply, the item would have to be identified by a label or other mark, and would have to have been removed by the premises or parking area of the owner or business served by the owner. The offense would be a misdemeanor punishable by up to 30 days in jail, a fine of up to \$250, or both.
