**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5396 AS INTRODUCED 1-17-90**

The School Code currently authorizes a school district to enter into agreements, when appropriate, with certain groups whose members are senior citizens, retired, or disabled in order to transport members to or from certain activities. Public Act 159 of 1989 amended the code to, among other things, allow a school board to enter into similar agreements for the use of school buses with certain nonprofit organizations; this act, however, has not yet become effective since the bill which amended the code -- Senate Bill 40 -- is tie-barred to another bill -- House Bill 4009 -- which has not yet been enacted. The bill essentially would reenact the provisions which allow schools to contract with nonprofit groups for the use of buses.
