Currently, under the State Employees' Retirement Act, a supplemental member (one employed in a "covered" position, including certain corrections department employees), may retire between the age of 51 and 62, under certain conditions, and receive a supplemental retirement benefit until age 62. The bill would amend the act to delete the requirement that a member be 51 years of age.
