A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5697 AS INTRODUCED 5-1-90

The bill would amend the School Aid Act to specify that, beginning July of 1990, if a school district that received "unencumbered" state school aid (that is, formula and categorical aid that was not fixed by a contract or a specific project grant) held more than 180 days of pupil instruction, the amount of the district's allocated aid would be increased by 1/180 for each additional school day over 180 up to 210. The increased payment would have to be made in the following fiscal year, added into the district's first school aid payment.
