A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5703 AS INTRODUCED 5-2-90

The bill would amend the Michigan Employment Security Act to permit the Michigan Employment Security Commission to issue a temporary identification number to an employer when an individual filed a claim for benefits based on employment with an employer who did not have an identification number. If the commission determined that there was sufficient information to believe that an employment relationship existed, and that the claimant was otherwise entitled to receive the benefits, the commission would issue a temporary identification number to the employer and would pay the claimant the proper benefit rate.
