A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5811 AS INTRODUCED 5-24-90

The bill would amend the emancipation of minors act, Public Act 293 of 1968, to provide for the emancipation of a minor for the purposes of consenting to routine, nonsurgical medical care or emergency treatment while a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections or while a probationer in a special alternative incarceration unit ("boot camp"). The emancipation would be by operation of law, meaning that a petition to the probate court would not be necessary.
