A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5839 AS INTRODUCED 5-29-90

The bill would allow automobile insurance companies to require customers to install ignition interlock devices in their vehicles or complete alcohol or drug education or treatment programs (or both) as a condition of providing them with auto insurance if the customers had been convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances or driving while impaired, or had been subject to an order of disposition of the probate court for such Michigan Vehicle Code violations. The provision would also apply to the Michigan Automobile Insurance Placement Facility, a state-sponsored "insurer of last resort" in which all auto insurers must participate.
