A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5917 AS INTRODUCED 6-21-90

Public Act 507 of 1988 allows charitable, religious, fraternal, or other nonprofit organizations to serve wild game that is not state inspected at fund-raising events if the organization posted a warning at the entrance to the dining area stating that the wild game had not been subject to state or federal inspection.

The bill would amend this part of the health code to allow these nonprofit organizations to serve uninspected game free of charge to poor people, provided that they posted the same notices.
