A REVISED SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5992 AS INTRODUCED 9-12-90

The Mental Health Code allows guardians for developmentally disabled people to be discharged or to have their duties modified under certain circumstances and after a court hearing. Currently, after holding a hearing, a court may take a number of actions regarding a guardianship: it may dismiss the petition, it may remove the guardianship and dissolve the guardianship order, it may remove the guardian and appoint another guardian, or it may modify the original guardianship order.

The bill would amend the code to say that if a court removes a guardianship and dissolves a guardianship order, the developmentally disabled person would regain all legal and civil rights that had been designated as legal disabilities or specifically granted to the guardian.
