A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 6027 AS INTRODUCED 9-13-90

The bill would amend the School Code to specify that a public high school would have to require its pupils, before they could graduate from high school, to successfully complete a parenting course. Under the bill, the State Board of Education would have to offer to school districts a recommended curriculum guide on how to implement the provision, which would have to include, at a minimum, recommended materials for teaching parenting as a separate high school course.
