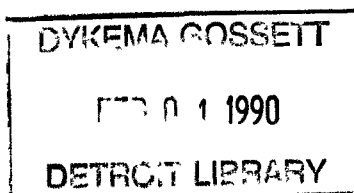

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4109-4111 AS INTRODUCED 2-7-89

The bills would provide that people applying for driver's licenses and state identification cards would be registered to vote at the same time unless they were not qualified or chose not to be registered. The application forms for those documents would be altered so that information needed for voter registration purposes could be acquired and so that applicants would have an opportunity to express a preference for not being registered. Applicants could also indicate that their address for voter registration purposes was different from that on their driver's licenses or identification cards. Similar provisions would apply also to change of address forms.

House Bill 4109 would amend Public Act 222 of 1972 (MCL 28.291) to apply to the official personal identification card. House Bill 4962 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code (MCL 257.307 and 257.315) to apply to the driver's license. House Bill 4963 would amend the Michigan Election Law (MCL 168.500a).
