A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5137 AS INTRODUCED 10-5-89

The Highway Advertising Act, which regulates the size, lighting, and spacing of signs and sign structures, specifies that general law townships with a population of 30,000 or more -- as well as cities, villages, and charter townships -- are authorized to enact sign control ordinances stricter than what the act provides for. The bill would amend the act to specify that a general law township, regardless of its size, could enact a sign control ordinance that was stricter than that specified in the act.
