A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5446 AS INTRODUCED 2-7-90

The Judges' Retirement Act temporarily provided for the disability retirement of a member with seven or more years of service, irrespective of age. From July 1, 1987 to June 30, 1988, a member who had seven or more years of credit and was physically or mentally totally and permanently incapacitated to perform his or her duties was able to retire with a pension or survivor's benefit reduced by one-eighth of the amount that would otherwise apply, meaning that the retiree would receive 50 percent of salary, reduced by one-eighth.

The bill would amend this provision to establish a "window period" from April 1, 1990 to September 30, 1990 during which it would again apply.
