A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5733 AS INTRODUCED 5-9-90

The bill would amend the Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act to permit the General Industry Safety Standards Commission, the Construction Safety Standards Commission, and the Occupational Health Standards Commission to promulgate standards that would regulate substance abuse in the workplace, including drug and alcohol testing and other medical examinations or tests considered necessary to control substance abuse. Employers would be responsible for the costs of tests and examinations prescribed under Occupational Health Standards Commission standards.
