**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5950 AS INTRODUCED 9-11-90**

The bill would amend Public Act 59 of 1935, the Department of State Police enabling act, to provide for disability payments to state police employees who were injured while performing employment duties. Until worker's compensation benefits began, an employee would receive full wages from the department. In addition, the department would also be required to pay its employees or employees of the Department of Natural Resources who received worker's compensation benefits that qualified for supplemental duty disability pay a supplement amounting to the difference between the worker's compensation benefits and wages received at the time of the injury. The employee's normal fringe benefits would remain in effect during the time the supplement was received. The provisions of the bill would also apply to employees who were receiving worker's compensation benefits on the bill's effective date.
