SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 29 as introduced 1-11-89:

The bill would amend the State trunkline highway system Act to prohibit the Department of Transportation from discriminating against the use of recycled materials when purchasing or contracting for road base or construction fill for the widening, improving, construction or reconstruction of State trunkline highways.
