SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 537 as introduced 7-27-89:

The bill would amend the charter township law to allow a township board by a twothirds vote to waive the law's residency requirements for a township superintendent. Under the law, a township superintendent need not be a resident of the township at the time of his or her appointment but must become a resident within 90 days of the appointment and remain a resident during his or her tenure in office. In addition to allowing the waiver of residency requirements, the bill would require that an individual who was a resident at the time of appointment also remain a resident through his or her tenure.
