SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 739 as introduced 1-23-90:

The bill would amend the Hunting and Fishing License Act to prohibit the Department of Natural Resources from issuing a fishing guide permit or license to a person who was not a Michigan resident if he or she were a resident of a state or country that did not issue such licenses or permits to Michigan residents.

FISCAL IMPACT

The bill would result in an indeterminate loss of fishing guide license or permit fee revenue, depending on the number of people who apply for a fishing guide license or permit from states or counties that do not reciprocate.
