SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 783 as introduced 2-6-90:

The bill would amend Public Act 189 of 1966, which regulates the procedures for obtaining and executing search warrants, to allow a warrant to be issued to search for and seize an individual for the purpose of an identification lineup or to obtain the person's photograph for a photo identification lineup.
