SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 149 as introduced 2-16-89:

The bill would amend the Public Health Code to repeal provisions on the creation of certain task forces that:

- Advise the Michigan Board of Nursing on licensed practical nursing as a subfield of the practice of nursing (MCL 333.17224).
- Advise the Michigan Board of Nursing on specialty certification for a registered professional nurse who had advanced training (MCL 333.17225).
- Advise the Michigan Board of Veterinary Medicine on the practice of a veterinary technician as a subfield of veterinary medicine (MCL 333.18824).
