## ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4472

AN ACT to amend Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended "An act to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of management and budget; to define the authority and functions of its director and its organizational entities; to authorize the department to issue directives; to provide for the capital outlay program; to provide for the leasing, planning, constructing, maintaining, altering, renovating, demolishing, conveying of lands and facilities; to provide for centralized administrative services such as purchasing, payroll, record retention, data processing, and publishing; to provide for a system of internal accounting and administrative control for certain principal departments; to provide for certain powers and duties of certain state officers and agencies; to codify, revise, consolidate, classify, and add to the powers, duties, and laws relative to budgeting, accounting, and the regulating of appropriations; to provide for the implementation of certain constitutional provisions; to create funds and accounts; to make appropriations; to prescribe penalties; to rescind certain executive reorganization orders; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as amended, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 353a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, as amended, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 353a to read as follows:

Sec. 353a. For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990 only, an appropriation shall be made from the fund in an amount as determined by section 212 of Act No. 181 of the Public Acts of 1989.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
