AN ACT to amend Act No. 641 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled "An act to protect the public health and the environment; to provide for the regulation and management of solid wastes including ash resulting from the combustion of certain solid wastes; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to impose certain charges on the disposal of solid waste in certain disposal areas; to provide for certain fees; to prescribe penalties; to make an appropriation; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as amended, being sections 299.401 to 299.437 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 18b.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 641 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being sections 299.401 to 299.437 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 18b to read as follows:

Sec. 18b. (1) Beginning 4 years after the effective date of this section, the open burning of grass clippings or leaves, or both, is prohibited in any municipality having a population of 7,500 or more, unless specifically authorized by local ordinance which shall be reported to the department of natural resources within 30 days of enactment.

(2) This section shall not be construed to allow a county or municipality to permit open burning of grass clippings or leaves, or both, by ordinance that would otherwise be prohibited under the air pollution act, Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of 1965, being sections 336.11 to 336.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, or rules promulgated under that act.
