## ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5057

AN ACT to authorize the department of corrections, on behalf of the state, to convey certain property; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of revenue derived from the conveyance.

## The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 1. The department of corrections, on behalf of the state, may convey to Blackman township, for fair market value, five acres, as determined by the department of corrections, of the parcel of land located in Jackson county near the northeast corner of O'Leary and Elm roads and described as follows:

Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter section 24, T2S, R1W.

This property shall be used as the location for a fire barn.

- Sec. 2. The revenue received under this act shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
- Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other minerals found on, within, or under the property conveyed.
