AN ACT to amend section 18 of Act No. 385 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled "An act to provide for the establishment of technology park districts in local governmental units; to provide certain facilities located in technology park districts an exemption from certain taxes; to levy and collect a specific tax upon the owners of certain facilities; to provide for the disposition of the tax; to provide for the obtaining and transferring of an exemption certificate and to prescribe the contents of those certificates; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state tax commission and certain officers of local governmental units; and to provide remedies and penalties," being section 207.718 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Section 1. Section 18 of Act No. 385 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 207.718 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 18. (1) A new exemption shall not be granted under this act after June 30, 1990, but an exemption then in effect shall continue until expiration of the certificate.
- (2) The in-depth analysis of the costs and benefits of this act in the communities where it has been utilized required under section 17 shall be submitted to the required committees of the senate and house of representatives not later than February 1, 1990.
