ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5220

AN ACT to amend section 306 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled "An act to regulate the taking and subsequent transport of game animals, game birds, fur-bearing animals, and fish; to provide for the issuing of licenses, permits, and stamps for the taking, catching, hunting, or killing of game animals, game birds, fur-bearing animals, and fish; to provide for the collection, disposition, and use of certain funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; to provide for certain immunities from civil and criminal liability; to provide penalties for the violation of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 316.306 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 306 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 316.306 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 306. (1) A person shall not hunt wild turkeys without a wild turkey hunting license. The fee for a resident wild turkey hunting license shall be \$9.50. The fee for a resident wild turkey hunting license for a senior citizen shall be \$1.00. The fee for a nonresident wild turkey hunting license shall be \$50.00. A person who is issued a small game license may make an application to the department for a wild turkey hunting license. Applications for a license to hunt wild turkeys shall be entered into a lottery designed and run by the department. A person selected in the lottery shall upon meeting the requirements of this act receive a wild turkey hunting license. The license shall be issued for a specified hunting period and shall confer upon the holder of the license the right to hunt wild turkeys.

(2) The fees collected for wild turkey hunting licenses shall be used for scientific research, biological survey work on wild turkeys, and wild turkey management in this state.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
