- 5 Sec. 1169. (1) The principal modes by which dangerous com-
- 6 municable diseases, including, but not limited to, acquired immu-
- 7 nodeficiency syndrome, are spread and the best methods for the
- 8 restriction and prevention of these diseases shall be taught in
- 9 every public school in this state.
