

HOUSE BILL No. 4090

February 7, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Joe Young, Sr., Joe Young, Jr., Kilpatrick, Watkins, Wallace and Gire and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend sections 1233 and 1293 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended "The school code of 1976," section 1233 as amended by Act No. 56 of the Public Acts of 1987, being sections 380.1233 and 380.1293 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 1233 and 1293 of Act No. 451 of the
2 Public Acts of 1976, section 1233 as amended by Act No. 56 of the
3 Public Acts of 1987, being sections 380.1233 and 380.1293 of the
4 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 1233. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3), the
6 board of a school district or intermediate school district shall
7 not permit a teacher who does not hold a valid teaching
8 certificate to teach in a grade or department of the school OR TO

1 TEACH ADULT BASIC EDUCATION, A COURSE IN A HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION
2 PROGRAM, OR A COURSE THAT PREPARES A PERSON TO TAKE THE GENERAL
3 EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TEST, or PERMIT a teacher without an
4 endorsement by the state board to serve in a counseling role as
5 the role is defined by the state board.

6 (2) The intermediate superintendent shall notify immediately
7 the state board of the names of noncertificated teachers and the
8 names of nonendorsed teachers serving in counseling roles, the
9 employing district, and the amount of time the noncertificated
10 and nonendorsed teachers were employed.

11 (3) The board of a school district or intermediate school
12 district may renew through June 30, 1995 an annual vocational
13 authorization of a noncertificated vocational teacher who is
14 employed by the district or intermediate school district on June
15 1, 1987, even if a certificated teacher is available for hire, if
16 both of the following conditions are met:

17 (a) The noncertificated teacher is annually and continually
18 enrolled and completing credit in an approved vocational teacher
19 preparation program leading to vocational certification.

20 (b) The noncertificated teacher has a planned vocational
21 teacher preparation program leading to vocational certification
22 on file with the employing school district or intermediate school
23 district, his or her teacher preparation institution, and the
24 department of education.

25 (4) A vocational teacher preparation institution shall uti-
26 lize the employment experience of an annually authorized teacher
27 for the purpose of waiving student teaching as a requirement for

1 vocational certification if the annually authorized teacher is
2 supervised by the teacher preparation institution.

3 (5) All vocational education teachers certified after
4 June 1, 1995 shall pass a competency test.

5 Sec. 1293. The board of a school district other than a pri-
6 mary district may provide instruction for adults. ~~and may~~ IF
7 INSTRUCTION IS PROVIDED IN ADULT BASIC EDUCATION, HIGH SCHOOL
8 COMPLETION, OR COURSES THAT PREPARE A PERSON TO TAKE THE GENERAL
9 EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TEST, THE BOARD SHALL employ ~~qualified~~
10 CERTIFIED teachers and provide the necessary equipment for ~~adult~~
11 ~~education~~ THE courses.
