## **HOUSE BILL No. 4118**

A bill to provide limited immunity from civil liability for certain persons who provide services for certain sports teams.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Compensation" means remuneration for services
