## **HOUSE BILL No. 4125**

February 9, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Honigman, Willis Bullard, Munsell, Dunaskiss and Jondahl and referred to the Committee on Taxation.

A bill to amend sections 1, 2, and 4 of Act No. 312 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled

"The metropolitan district act,"

being sections 119.1, 119.2, and 119.4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1, 2, and 4 of Act No. 312 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1929, being sections 119.1, 119.2, and 119.4 of
- 3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. Any COMBINATION OF 2 or more cities; villages;
- 5 or townships; or any combination or parts thereof OF
- 6 CITIES, VILLAGES, OR TOWNSHIPS, may incorporate into a metropoli-
- 7 tan district or districts comprising territory within their
- 8 respective limits for the purpose of acquiring, owning,
- 9 PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, operating, and maintaining either

- 1 within or without their limits as may be established
- 2 hereunder, parks; PARKING FACILITIES; or public utilities for
- 3 supplying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or transportation.
- 4 or any combination thereof. Each organized A PUBLIC UTILITY
- 5 FOR SUPPLYING TRANSPORTATION INCLUDES A RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM,
- 6 WHICH MAY CONSIST OF A TUNNEL, SUBWAY, SURFACE, OR ELEVATED
- 7 SYSTEM. A district hereunder shall be CREATED UNDER THIS ACT
- 8 IS a body corporate.
- 9 Sec. 2. -Any- A district incorporated under this act -shall
- 10 have the power to MAY acquire, own, PURCHASE, CONSTRUCT, oper-
- 11 ate, and maintain, within or without its limits, parks; PARKING
- 12 FACILITIES; or public utilities for supplying sewage disposal,
- 13 drainage, water, or transportation or -any combination thereof or
- 14 such of said powers as may be MAY DO ANY COMBINATION OF THESE
- 15 THINGS AS ARE designated in its charter. Any such A district
- 16 may sell or purchase, either within or without its limits, sewage
- 17 disposal or drainage rights -- OR water or transportation facil-

- 4 Sec. 4. Each district incorporated under the provisions
- 5 hereof OF THIS ACT may provide THE FOLLOWING in its charter:
- 6 (a) For annually laying and collecting taxes in a sum not to
- 7 exceed 1/2% of 1 per centum of the assessed value of all real
- 8 and personal property in the district.
- 9 (b) For borrowing money on the credit of the district in a
- 10 sum not to exceed 2% per centum of the assessed value of all
- 11 real and personal property in the district for the purpose of
- 12 acquiring, owning, purchasing, constructing, maintaining, or
- 13 operating parks; PARKING FACILITIES; or public utilities for sup-
- 14 plying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or transportation. -
- 15 or any combination thereof: Provided, That any such FOR THESE
- 16 PURPOSES, A district may borrow money and issue bonds -for any of
- 17 the above purposes or any combination thereof which will THAT
- 18 impose no liability upon the district but which AND may be paid
- 19 and ARE secured only by special -assessment levied against each
- 20 parcel for the particular public improvement herein provided for
- 21 and for the payment of which bonds are issued: Provided further,
- 22 That any ASSESSMENTS. A district incorporated under the provi-
- 23 sions hereof, may, for the purpose of acquiring, owning, pur-
- 24 chasing, constructing, or operating -any A SEWAGE DISPOSAL,
- 25 DRAINAGE, WATER, OR TRANSPORTATION public utility, herein pro-
- 26 vided for, issue mortgage bonds -therefor, or any combination
- 27 thereof, which said mortgage bonds may be issued beyond the

- 1 general limit of bonded indebtedness prescribed by this act. -:
- 2 Provided, That such mortgage bonds A MORTGAGE BOND issued beyond
- 3 the general limits of bonded indebtedness shall not impose any
- 4 liability upon the district but shall be secured only upon the
- 5 property and revenues of -such THE public utility, including the
- 6 franchise. -, stating THE MORTGAGE BOND SHALL STATE the terms
- 7 upon which, in case of foreclosure, the purchaser may operate the
- 8 same PUBLIC UTILITY, which franchise shall in no case NOT
- 9 extend for a longer period than 20 years from the date of -such-
- 10 THE sale of -such THE utility and franchise on foreclosure. --
- 11 And provided, That said THE mortgage bond shall be sold for not
- 12 less than par AND bear interest at a rate not in excess of
- 13 6%, per centum, and the total amount thereof OF THE MORTGAGE
- 14 BONDS shall not exceed 60% -per-centum of the original cost of
- 15 the utility. -: And provided further, That the THE charter of
- 16 -any such A district ISSUING MORTGAGE BONDS shall provide for
- 17 the creation of a sinking fund by setting aside -such- A percen-
- 18 tage of the gross or net earnings of the public utility -as may
- 19 be deemed sufficient for the payment of the mortgage bonds at
- 20 maturity.
- 21 (c) For a lien LIENS on any property and for taxes for
- 22 the payment of -any- bonds issued or for the cost and expense of
- 23 -making any improvement herein provided for IMPROVEMENTS MADE
- 24 PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.
- 25 (d) For laying and collecting rents, tolls, and excises.
- (e) For a special assessment district to <del>provide for</del>
- 27 RECOVER the cost and expense of any ACQUIRING, OWNING,

1 PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, OPERATING, OR MAINTAINING A park,

- 2 PARKING FACILITY, or public utility -, or combination thereof,
- 3 herein provided for PURSUANT TO THIS ACT. IF THE DISTRICT
- 4 RECOVERS THE COST OF ACQUIRING, OWNING, PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING,
- 5 OPERATING, AND MAINTAINING A PARK OR PARKING FACILITY ENTIRELY BY
- 6 SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE DISTRICT MAY
- 7 LIMIT ACCESS TO THE PARK OR PARKING FACILITY TO THE OWNERS AND
- 8 OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY IN THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND
- 9 THEIR GUESTS AND PATRONS.
- (f) For the purchase or condemnation of the franchises, if
- 11 any exist, and of the property used in the operation of com-
- 12 panies or individuals engaged in or operating public utilities
- 13 for supplying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or
- 14 transportation. -, or any combination thereof. And each A dis-
- 15 trict may in its charter provide that it may make a contract,
- 16 upon -such terms -, including terms of present or deferred pay
- 17 ment and upon such conditions and in such manner as THAT the
- 18 district may deem CONSIDERS proper, to purchase, operate, and
- 19 maintain -any existing public utility property for supplying
- 20 sewage disposal, drainage, water, or transportation -, or any
- 21 combination thereof within or without its limits. ; if IF THE
- 22 UTILITY PROPERTY IS FOR SUPPLYING SERVICE without -its- THE
- 23 DISTRICT'S limits, then -such THE purchase -must OF THE UTILITY
- 24 PROPERTY SHALL be incidental to the operation and maintenance of
- 25 -such THE public utility. -No-such SUCH A contract -shall-
- 26 DOES NOT bind the district unless the proposition therefor shall
- 27 receive TO ENTER THE CONTRACT RECEIVES the affirmative vote of

- 24 the provisions hereof relating to other public utilities shall
- 25 apply thereto.
