A bill to amend the title and sections 1 and 2 of Act
No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1923, entitled as amended
"Township and village public improvement act,"
being sections 41.411 and 41.412 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 116 of
- 2 the Public Acts of 1923, being sections 41.411 and 41.412 of the
- 3 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 TITLE
- 5 An act to authorize CERTAIN TOWNSHIP OR VILLAGE PUBLIC
- 6 improvements AND SERVICES AND TO PROVIDE METHODS FOR FINANCING
- 7 THE IMPROVEMENTS AND SERVICES. in and for lands in townships or
- 8 waters, adjacent or contiquous thereto, by constructing bridges
- 9 over natural or artificial waterways, grading, paving, curbing,
- 10 stoning, graveling, macadamizing or cinderizing streets, laying

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- 1 storm sewers to care for surface water in such streets,
- 2 destroying weeds, providing street markers and lighting, con-
- 3 tracting for public transportation facilities, providing police
- 4 protection or contracting therefor, establishing and maintaining
- 5 garbage systems or plants for the collection and disposal of gar-
- 6 bage or contracting therefor, constructing or acquiring and main
- 7 taining sanitary sewers and sewage disposal plants, constructing
- 8 filtration plants, constructing sidewalks, purchasing or con-
- 9 structing waterworks, purchasing or contracting for fire appa-
- 10 ratus and equipment, constructing and maintaining housing facili
- 11 ties for fire apparatus and equipment, making extension of water
- 12 mains to provide water for fire protection and domestic uses, for
- 13 the trimming and spraying of trees and shrubbery, and construct
- 14 ing breakwaters, retaining walls or sea walls, or any combination
- 15 of the foregoing for beach and soil erosion control, providing
- 16 for the suppression of swimmers' itch and other aquatic
- 17 nuisance producing organisms; to provide for making, levying and
- 18 collecting of special assessments to pay the cost thereof, and to
- 19 issue special assessment bonds in anticipation of the collection
- 20 of such special assessment taxes to provide the money with which
- 21 to pay the cost of such improvements, and advance the amount nec-
- 22 essary to pay such bonds and reimburse the township for such
- 23 advances, and if necessary thereto to reassess the district.
- Sec. 1. (1) In -any township lands, the township board or
- 25 common council or board of trustees of an incorporated village
- 26 -shall have the authority to make MAY MAKE PUBLIC improvements

1 and provide public service by constructing DOING 1 OR MORE OF
2 THE FOLLOWING:

- 3 (A) CONSTRUCTING bridges over natural or artificial

- 5 (B) GRADING, paving, curbing, stoning, graveling,
- 6 macadamizing, or cinderizing streets. -, or to treat the
- 7 (C) TREATING streets with chloride or other suitable dust
- 8 laying process or material. -, laying
- 9 (D) LAYING storm sewers to care for surface water in -such-
- 10 streets. destroying
- 11 (E) DESTROYING weeds. -, providing
- 12 (F) PROVIDING street markers and lighting. , contracting
- (G) CONTRACTING for public transportation facilities. -
- 14 providing
- 15 (H) ACOUIRING OR CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING, AND OPERATING
- 16 PARKING FACILITIES.
- (I) PROVIDING police protection or contracting therefor,
- 18 establishing FOR POLICE PROTECTION.
- (J) ESTABLISHING and maintaining garbage and mixed refuse
- 20 systems or plants for the collection and disposal of garbage and
- 21 mixed refuse or contracting for such collection and disposal for
- 22 not to exceed 30 years. -, constructing
- 23 (K) CONSTRUCTING or acquiring and maintaining sanitary
- 24 sewers and sewage disposal plants or equipment. -, constructing
- 25 (1) CONSTRUCTING filtration plants. -, constructing
- 26 (M) CONSTRUCTING sidewalks. purchasing

- 1 (N) PURCHASING or constructing waterworks. -, purchasing
- 2 (O) PURCHASING fire apparatus and equipment. —
- 3 constructing
- 4 (P) CONSTRUCTING and maintaining housing facilities for fire
- 5 apparatus and equipment. -, making extension-
- 6 (Q) MAKING EXTENSIONS of water mains to provide water for
- 7 fire protection and domestic uses. -, for the trimming
- 8 (R) TRIMMING and spraying of trees and shrubbery. -, to
- 9 provide and maintain
- 10 (S) PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING soil and beach erosion control
- 11 measures including, but not limited to, the construction of
- 12 breakwaters, retaining walls, -or AND sea walls, -or any combi-
- 13 nation of the foregoing, in or for any such TOWNSHIP lands or
- 14 waters adjacent or contiguous thereto, to establish and conduct
- 15 TO THESE LANDS.
- 16 (T) ESTABLISHING AND CONDUCTING chemical beach treatment
- 17 service necessary to FOR the control of aquatic nuisances such
- 18 as swimmers' itch or -to-contract CONTRACTING with others to
- 19 provide -said THE services. ; to levy
- 20 (U) ACQUIRING, MAINTAINING, AND OPERATING PARKS.
- 21 (2) A TOWNSHIP BOARD OR COMMON COUNCIL OR BOARD OF TRUSTEES
- 22 OF AN INCORPORATED VILLAGE SHALL LEVY and collect special assess-
- 23 ments to pay the cost -thereof and to OF AN IMPROVEMENT OR SERV-
- 24 ICE MADE OR PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) AND issue bonds in
- 25 anticipation of the collection of -said THE special assessments,
- 26 upon THE filing OF the petition and subject to the terms and
- 27 conditions -hereinafter provided IN THIS ACT.

- 1 (3) In AN incorporated -villages VILLAGE, the common
- 2 council or board of trustees -thereof shall be IS vested with
- 3 and shall perform the powers and duties vested BY THIS ACT in the
- 4 township board in areas outside OF THE incorporated villages
- 5 VILLAGE.
- 6 (4) The township board, or common council, or board of
- 7 trustees of -any- AN incorporated village may purchase, accept by
- 8 gift or -device- DEVISE, or condemn private property. If THE
- 9 PROPERTY IS TO BE ACQUIRED by condemnation, the provisions of Act
- 10 No. 149 of the Public Acts of 1911, as amended, being sections
- 11 213.21 to -213.41 213.25 of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws; -of
- 12 +948, THE UNIFORM CONDEMNATION PROCEDURES ACT, ACT NO. 87 OF THE
- 13 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1980, BEING SECTIONS 213.51 TO 213.77 OF THE
- 14 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS; or -such- other appropriate provisions
- 15 thereof as exist or shall be made by OF law _ may be adopted
- 16 and used for the purpose of instituting and prosecuting -such-
- 17 THE condemnation proceedings.
- 18 (5) This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 19 "township and village public improvement AND PUBLIC SERVICE
- 20 act".
- 21 Sec. 2. (1) Upon the filing of petitions verified both as
- 22 to signature and ownership, signed by record owners of land to be
- 23 made into a special assessment district, in which any of the
- 24 improvements AN IMPROVEMENT OR SERVICE specified in section 1
- 25 -are IS desired by the owners of -such THE land, the township
- 26 board shall have power to construct and maintain such
- 27 improvements, to MAY UNDERTAKE THE IMPROVEMENT OR SERVICE,

- 1 determine the cost -thereof OF THE IMPROVEMENT OR SERVICE, and
- 2 -to- create, define, and establish a special assessment district
- 3 within all or within and comprising not less than 80% -per
- 4 centum of such THE area. and upon which district the THE
- 5 cost of -such- THE improvement OR SERVICE shall be levied
- 6 -: Provided, however, That such petition, verified as to signa-
- 7 ture and ownership, shall have been signed by UPON THE
- 8 DISTRICT. HOWEVER, the record owners of not less than 65% -per
- 9 centum of the land actually created into -such THE special
- 10 assessment district by -said THE township board -, and a MUST
- 11 HAVE SIGNED THE PETITIONS.
- 12 (2) A district established and assessed may be enlarged
- 13 through a petition, circulated and signed as required for an
- 14 original district, but covering only the area to be added to
- 15 create the enlarged district. , and benefits BENEFITS of an
- 16 improvement OR SERVICE MAY BE extended to the added part, and the
- 17 entire enlarged district MAY BE assessed for the -same-
- 18 IMPROVEMENT OR SERVICE, as provided for an original district.
- 19 The term "improvement" shall include any service authorized
- 20 hereunder. Where IF a service has been instituted -but AND no
- 21 assessment bonds FOR THE SERVICE are outstanding, therefor,
- 22 such THE service may be discontinued upon petition by owners of
- 23 a like percentage 65% of THE lands.
- 24 (3) THE TOWNSHIP BOARD MAY LIMIT ACCESS TO A PARK TO OWNERS
- 25 AND OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY IN THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND
- 26 THEIR GUESTS AND PATRONS IF THE PARK IS ACQUIRED, MAINTAINED, AND
- 27 OPERATED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT. THE TOWNSHIP BOARD MAY LIMIT

1 ACCESS TO A PARKING FACILITY TO OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY

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- 2 IN THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND THEIR GUESTS AND PATRONS
- 3 IF THE PARKING FACILITY IS ACQUIRED OR CONSTRUCTED, MAINTAINED,
- 4 AND OPERATED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.
