

HOUSE BILL No. 4140

February 9, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Bennane, DeMars and Gubow and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "Public health code," as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 16269.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 16269 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 16269. (1) A LICENSEE WHO OWNS OR OPERATES A PRIVATE
6 PRACTICE OFFICE, A CLINICAL LABORATORY LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 17,
7 OR A CLINICAL LABORATORY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 20507 AND WHO
8 HANDLES INFECTIOUS MEDICAL WASTE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE INFECTIOUS
9 MEDICAL WASTE REGULATORY ACT.

1 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH SHALL PROMULGATE RULES
2 TO PRESCRIBE TRAINING STANDARDS FOR BOTH MEDICAL AND NONMEDICAL
3 PERSONNEL WHO HANDLE INFECTIOUS MEDICAL WASTE IN FACILITIES
4 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1).

5 (3) EACH LICENSEE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL TRAIN
6 HIS OR HER EMPLOYEES PURSUANT TO THE RULES PROMULGATED UNDER
7 SUBSECTION (2).

8 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "INFECTIOUS MEDICAL WASTE"
9 MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE INFECTIOUS MEDICAL
10 WASTE REGULATORY ACT.

11 Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect March 1,
12 1990.

13 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
14 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4136 (request
15 no. 00587'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
