THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 22 and 24 of Act No. 84 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1929, being sections 308.22 and 308.24 of the Michigan

- 6 Beginning in the year 1966, there will be a ban on the issu-
