A bill to amend the title and sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 119 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled

"An act to regulate the business of buying or receiving used motor vehicle parts; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local officers; and to provide penalties,"

being sections 257.1351 and 257.1352 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 119 of
- 2 the Public Acts of 1986, being sections 257.1351 and 257.1352 of
- 3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 TITLE
- 5 An act to regulate the business of buying or receiving used
- 6 motor vehicle parts; to prescribe the powers and duties of
- 7 certain STATE AGENCIES AND state and local officers; and to
- 8 provide penalties.

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Agent" means a person who, for compensation or valuable
- 3 consideration, is employed either directly or indirectly by a
- 4 dealer.
- 5 (b) "Dealer" means any person, corporation, partnership, or
- 6 association, which, in whole or in part, engages in the ordinary
- 7 course of repeated and recurrent transactions of buying or
- 8 receiving used motor vehicle parts from persons other than a
- 9 licensee. A dealer shall include any motor vehicle repair facil-
- 10 ity which engages in repeated and recurrent transactions of
- 11 buying or receiving used motor vehicle parts from persons other
- 12 than a licensee. Dealer does not include a scrap metal processor
- 13 who buys or otherwise acquires motor vehicles or motor vehicle
- 14 component parts for the purpose of processing or selling the
- 15 metal for remelting.
- (c) "Late model vehicle" means a motor vehicle manufactured
- 17 in the current model year or the 5 model years immediately pre-
- 18 ceding the current model year.
- (d) "Local police agency" means the police agency of the
- 20 city, village, or township, or if none, the county sheriff.
- 21 (e) "Major component part" means 1 of the following subas-
- 22 semblies of a motor vehicle regardless of its actual market
- 23 value: -front-
- 24 (i) FRONT end assembly, including fenders, grills, hood,
- 25 bumper, and related parts. -; engine; transmission; T tops;
- 26 rear

- (ii) ENGINE.
- 2 (iii) TRANSMISSION.
- 3 (iv) T-TOPS.
- 4 (v) REAR clip assembly, including quarter panels and floor
- 5 panel assembly. ; doors; tires,
- $6 \quad (vi) \text{ DOORS}.$
- 7 (vii) TIRES, tire wheels, and continuous treads.
- 8 (f) "Motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in sec-
- 9 tion 33 of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public
- 10 Acts of 1949, being section 257.33 of the Michigan Compiled
- 11 Laws.
- (g) "Motor vehicle repair facility" means a place of busi-
- 13 ness which engages in the business of performing or employing
- 14 persons who perform maintenance, diagnosis, VEHICLE BODY WORK, or
- 15 repair service on a motor vehicle for compensation.
- (h) "Licensee" means a person, partnership, corporation, or
- 17 association licensed under section 248 of the Michigan vehicle
- 18 code, Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, being section
- 19 257.248 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, or similarly licensed in
- 20 another state.
- 21 (I) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF STATE, ACTING
- 22 DIRECTLY OR THROUGH AN AUTHORIZED DEPUTY, INVESTIGATOR, AGENT, OR
- 23 EMPLOYEE.
- 24 (J) (i) "Used motor vehicle part" means any major compo-
- 25 nent part, dashboard, radio, stereo, or seat of a late model
- 26 motor vehicle for which a certificate of title and registration
- 27 plate have been issued to a consumer or dealer.

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) A dealer shall maintain a permanent record of
- 2 each transaction concerning the buying or receiving of any used
- 3 motor vehicle part from a person other than a licensee, on record
- 4 of transaction forms provided for in subsection (5), legibly
- 5 written in ink in the English language. Each record of transac-
- 6 tion form shall be filled out in duplicate by the dealer or agent
- 7 with 1 copy going to the customer, and 1 copy to be retained by
- 8 the dealer. At the time a dealer receives or purchases a used
- 9 motor vehicle part from a person other than a licensee, the
- 10 dealer or agent shall accurately record all of the following
- 11 information on a record of transaction form:
- (a) A general description of the used motor vehicle part
- 13 received or purchased.
- (b) The vehicle identification number of the vehicle the
- 15 used motor vehicle part came from.
- (c) The state of origin of the used motor vehicle part.
- 17 (d) The date of the transaction.
- (e) The name of the person conducting the transaction for
- 19 the dealer.
- 20 (f) The name, date of birth, driver's license number or
- 21 state of Michigan personal identification card number, and street
- 22 and house number of the person with whom the transaction is
- 23 being made, together with a legible imprint of the right thumb
- 24 of the person with whom the transaction is made, or if that is
- 25 not possible, then the left thumb or a finger of that person.
- 26 However, the thumbprint or fingerprint shall only be required on
- 27 the record of transaction form retained by the dealer. The

- 1 thumb- print or fingerprint shall be made available to the
- 2 SECRETARY, A local police agency, or the department of state
- 3 police only during the course of -a police AN investigation
- 4 involving a used motor vehicle part described on the record of
- 5 transaction. This -paragraph SUBDIVISION shall not apply to a
- 6 transaction involving an insurance company that has acquired
- 7 ownership of a late model vehicle by the payment of damages due
- 8 to an accident and a dealer that buys the vehicle from the insur-
- 9 ance company for salvage.
- (g) The price paid or to be paid by the dealer for the used
- 11 motor vehicle part.
- (h) The form of payment made to the customer. The dealer
- 13 shall indicate the number of a check, money order, or bank
- 14 draft.
- 15 (i) The signature of the person with whom the transaction is
- 16 made.
- 17 (2) The record of each transaction shall be numbered consec-
- 18 utively, commencing with the number 1 and the calendar year.
- (3) The record of transaction forms of a dealer and each
- 20 used motor vehicle part received by a dealer as the result of a
- 21 transaction shall be open to an inspection by the SECRETARY, A
- 22 local police agency, and the Michigan state police at all times
- 23 during the ordinary business hours of the dealer. As a condition
- 24 of doing business, a dealer shall be considered to have given
- 25 consent to the inspection prescribed by this subsection. The
- 26 record of transaction forms of a dealer shall -not be open to
- 27 inspection by BE EXEMPT FROM DISCLOSURE TO the general public.

1	(4) Each record of a transaction shall be retained by the			
2	dealer for not less than I year after the transaction to which			
3	the record pertains. A dealer who goes out of business or			
4	changes his or her business address to another local jurisdiction			
5	either within or out of this state shall transmit to the local			
6	police agency the records of all transactions made by the dealer			
7	not more than I year before his or her closing or moving. After			
8	a period of 1 year from the date of the transaction, if $-a$			
9	police AN investigation concerning a used motor vehicle part			
10	O described on the record of transaction has not occurred, the			
11	1 dealer and local police agency shall destroy, and not keep a per-			
12	2 manent record of, the records of the transaction.			
13	(5) The form of the record of transaction shall be $8-1/2$ by			
14	11 inches in size and shall be as follows:
