HOUSE BILL No. 4241

February 21, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Gire, DeMars, Ciaramitaro and Wallace and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Macomb county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyances; and to provide for the disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the highest bidder, for fair market value as
- 3 determined pursuant to section 2, certain property now under the
- 4 jurisdiction of the department of management and budget and
- 5 located at the corner of 15 Mile and Hayes road in the township
- 6 of Clinton, Macomb county, Michigan, and more specifically
- 7 described as follows:
- 8 A Parcel of land located in and being a part of the
- 9 Southwest 1/4 quarter of Section 30, T2N, R13E, Clinton Township,
- 10 Macomb County, Michigan, and being more particularly described as

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- 1 follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Section 30;
- 2 thence North 1 degree 20'22" W measured along the West line of
- 3 said Section 30, (centerline of Hayes Road), a distance of 484.20
- 4 feet; thence North 88 degrees 32'50" East, 538.71 feet; thence S
- 5 02 degrees 48'00" East 484.20 feet to the South line of said
- 6 Section 30; thence South 88 degrees 32 minutes West a distance of
- 7 551.05 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to the rights of
- 8 the public and of any governmental unit in part thereof taken,
- 9 used or deeded for street, road or highway purposes, reserving a
- 10 non-exclusive easement over the easterly 62 feet thereof for the
- 11 installation of underground utility lines and for ingress and
- 12 egress for vehicles and pedestrians.
- 13 Sec. 2. The fair market value of the property described in
- 14 section 1 shall be determined by an appraisal based on the
- 15 property's highest and best use, as prepared by the state tax
- 16 commission.
- 17 Sec. 3. The conveyance of this parcel will be subject to
- 18 all easements, restrictions, or encumbrances of record.
- 19 Sec. 4. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 20 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general.
- 21 Sec. 5. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 22 that the state shall retain all rights to oil, coal, gas, or
- 23 other materials, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetal-
- 24 lic minerals found on, within, or under the conveyed land.
- 25 Sec. 6. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 26 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.

1 Thirty-seven percent of the revenue received under this act shall

2 be appropriated to the city of Detroit.
