A bill to amend the title and sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the issuance of veterans' licenses without cost to former members of the coast guard, soldiers, sailors or marines of the military or naval service of the United States, to hawk, vend and peddle their own goods, wares and merchandise within this state."

being sections 35.441, 35.442, and 35.443 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act
- 2 No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1921, being sections 35.441,
- 3 35.442, and 35.443 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to
- 4 read as follows:

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1 TITLE

- 2 An act to provide for the issuance of veterans' licenses
- 3 without cost to former members of the -coast quard, soldiers,
- 4 sailors or marines of the military or naval service ARMED FORCES
- 5 of the United States to hawk, vend and peddle SELL their
- 6 own goods -, wates and merchandise within this state; AND TO
- 7 PRESCRIBE PENALTIES.
- 8 Sec. 1. (1) Every honorably discharged member of the -coast
- 9 guard, soldier, sailor or marine of the military or naval
- 10 service ARMED FORCES of the United States who is a resident
- 11 of this state -, and a veteran of the War of the Rebellion, or
- 12 of the Spanish American War, or of the World War I, or of
- 13 World War II, or of any other war in which the United States of
- 14 America has been or shall be a participant, -shall have- HAS the
- 15 right to hawk, vend and peddle SELL his OR HER own goods -
- 16 wares and merchandise within this state -- by procuring a
- 17 license for that purpose -to-be- issued as -herein- provided IN
- 18 THIS ACT, which shall be valid for a period of 1 year.
- 19 (2) For EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), FOR the pur-
- 20 poses of the administration of this act, a Michigan veteran of
- 21 World War II shall be deemed to be IS any person , male or
- 22 female, whose legal residence is in Michigan, who entered upon
- 23 or was in active service in the army, navy, marine corps or
- 24 coast guard, ARMED FORCES of the United States , at any time
- 25 for at least 90 days from -and after- August 27, 1940, UP to and
- 26 including the date of the termination of World War II, whether by
- 27 induction, enlistment, commission, warrant, or otherwise, and who

- 1 has been honorably discharged, retired, or separated -therefrom,
- 2 FROM ACTIVE MILITARY SERVICE or who has reverted to an inactive
- 3 status therefrom under honorable conditions. -: Provided,
- 4 That former members
- 5 (3) A FORMER MEMBER of the women's auxiliary army corps who
- 6 refused to accept transfer to or induction into the women's army
- 7 corps shall not be deemed to be veterans within the meaning of
- 8 this definition CONSIDERED A MICHIGAN VETERAN OF WORLD WAR II.
- 9 Sec. 2. (1) -On- UPON the presentation to the clerk of any
- 10 county in which any former member of the -coast guard, sol-
- 11 dier, sailor or marine may reside, ARMED FORCES RESIDES of a
- 12 certificate of honorable discharge from the -coast guard, army,
- 13 navy or marine corps ARMED FORCES of the United States, which
- 14 discharge shall show SHOWING that the person presenting it is a
- 15 veteran of the War of the Rebellion, or of the Spanish American
- 16 War, or of the World War I, or of World War II, or of any
- 17 other war in which the United States of America has been or shall
- 18 be a participant, -such THE county clerk shall issue without
- 19 cost to -such THE veteran a veteran's license certifying
- 20 him OR HER to be entitled to the benefits of this act. The
- 21 county clerk shall provide himself with proper blank forms
- 22 and books and shall keep a record of all licenses issued under
- 23 the provisions of this act. A veteran's license issued
- 24 -without cost under -the provisions of this act -, shall be IS
- 25 personal to the licensee. -and any AN assignment or transfer
- 26 thereof shall be absolutely OF THE LICENSE IS void.

- 1 (2) IF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF GOODS UNDER THIS ACT
- 2 ARE USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED FOR THE DIRECT PERSONAL BENEFIT
- 3 OR GAIN OF THE VETERAN LICENSED TO SELL THE GOODS, THEN AT THE
- 4 TIME OF SALE A WRITTEN STATEMENT OF NOT LESS THAN 24-POINT BOLD-
- 5 FACE TYPE SHALL BE PRINTED ON OR ATTACHED TO THE GOODS, IN SUB-
- 6 STANTIALLY THE FOLLOWING FORM:
- 7 "THE PROFIT FROM THE SALE OF THIS PRODUCT IS FOR MY PERSONAL
- 8 BENEFIT".
- 9 (3) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY MAKE A FALSE REPRESENTATION
- 10 THAT THE PROCEEDS FROM GOODS SOLD UNDER THIS ACT BENEFIT A
- 11 VETERANS' ORGANIZATION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION "VETERANS'
- 12 ORGANIZATION" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (A) A VETERANS' ORGANIZATION CHARTERED UNDER FEDERAL LAW.
- 14 (B) AN ORGANIZATION COMPOSED OF VETERANS AS DEFINED IN ACT
- 15 NO. 190 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1965, BEING SECTIONS 35.61 TO 35.62
- 16 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, THAT IS ORGANIZED FOR A BONA FIDE
- 17 FRATERNAL, BENEVOLENT, EDUCATIONAL, PHILANTHROPIC, HUMANE, PATRI-
- 18 OTIC, OR ELEEMOSYNARY PURPOSE.
- 19 (4) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (2) OR (3) IS GUILTY OF
 20 A MISDEMEANOR.
- 21 Sec. 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed as contra-
- 22 vening the provisions of Act No. -191- 51 of the Public Acts of
- 23 -1901 or Act No. 294 of the Public Acts of 1913, as amended,
- 24 known as the "itinerant vendors" and "transient merchants" acts
- 25 1925, BEING SECTIONS 445.371 TO 445.378 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
- 26 LAWS.
