A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 298 of the Public Acts of 1917, entitled as amended

"An act to authorize cities and villages to levy a tax for the purpose of collecting and disposing of garbage; and providing for the issuance of bonds therefor,"

being section 123.261 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 298 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1917, being section 123.261 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is

- 4 Sec. 1. (1) The city council of a city, whether organized
