

HOUSE BILL No. 4286

February 23, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Martin, Dunaskiss, Jaye, Runco, Emmons, DeLange and Crandall and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend Act No. 1 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1936, entitled as amended "Michigan employment security act," as amended, being sections 421.1 to 421.73 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 28b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 1 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1936, as amended, being sections 421.1 to 421.73 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 28b to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 28B. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP A PLAN BASED ON
6 THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE REEMPLOYMENT DEMONSTRATION PROJECT
7 CONDUCTED BY THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY. THE PLAN SHALL INCLUDE
8 PROVISIONS FOR INTENSIVE JOB SEARCH ASSISTANCE, JOB TRAINING AND
9 POSSIBLE RELOCATION ASSISTANCE, AND PROVISIONS FOR PAYMENT OF A

1 REEMPLOYMENT BONUS TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FINDS WORK AS A RESULT OF
2 ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE PLAN.

3 (2) THE PLAN SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION AND
4 PRESENTED TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR WITHIN 6
5 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.

6 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT AS SOON AS
7 POSSIBLE IF FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT ARE APPROVED BY THE UNITED
8 STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.
