

HOUSE BILL No. 4317

March 1, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Van Regenmorter and Webb and referred to the Committee on Liquor Control.

A bill to amend Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended

"The Michigan liquor control act,"

as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 57a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 57a to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 57A. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 56, A CITY, VILLAGE,
6 OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THERE ARE NO RETAIL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF
7 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY, BY ORDINANCE, PROHIBIT THE SALE OF
8 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN ITS BORDERS.

1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE" MEANS
2 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2.
