## **HOUSE BILL No. 4357**

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Pridnia and Ouwinga and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 721 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

being section 257.721 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 721 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1949, being section 257.721 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 721. (1) A EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSEC-
- 5 TION (5), A passenger vehicle OR A PICKUP TRUCK shall not be
- 6 driven upon a highway drawing or having attached to the passenger
- 7 vehicle OR PICKUP TRUCK more than 1 vehicle or trailer.
- 8 (2) The drawbar or other connection between 2 vehicles, 1 of
- 9 which is towing or drawing the other on a highway, shall not
- 10 exceed 15 feet in length from 1 vehicle to the other. If the

- 1 connection consists of a chain, rope, or cable, there shall be
- 2 displayed upon the connection a red flag or other signal or cloth
- 3 not less than 12 inches both in length and width.
- 4 (3) A vehicle or trailer TOWED OR drawn by a -motor
- 5 propelled vehicle shall be -so attached to the vehicle with
- 6 forms of coupling devices which will prevent the vehicle or
- 7 trailer from being deflected more than 6 inches from the path of
- 8 the towing vehicle's wheels IN A MANNER SO THAT WHEN THE COMBI-
- 9 NATION IS OPERATED IN A LINEAR ALIGNMENT ON A LEVEL, SMOOTH,
- 10 PAVED SURFACE, THE MOVEMENT OF THE TOWED OR DRAWN VEHICLE OR
- 11 TRAILER DOES NOT DEVIATE MORE THAN 3 INCHES TO EITHER SIDE OF THE
- 12 PATH OF THE TOWING VEHICLE THAT TOWS OR DRAWS IT. The vehicle or
- 13 trailer shall also be connected to the towing vehicle, by suit-
- 14 able safety chains or devices, 1 on each side of the coupling and
- 15 at the extreme outer edge of the vehicle OR TRAILER and each
- 16 chain or device and connection used shall be of sufficient
- 17 strength to haul the VEHICLE OR trailer when loaded.
- 18 (4) A PICKUP TRUCK WITH A FIFTH WHEEL ASSEMBLY SHALL NOT TOW
- 19 A SEMITRAILER UNLESS THE FIFTH WHEEL ASSEMBLY CONFORMS TO MOTOR
- 20 CARRIER SAFETY RULE R 460.16442 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE
- 21 CODE.
- 22 (5) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1), A PICKUP TRUCK WITH A
- 23 MANUFACTURER'S GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF NOT LESS THAN 8,500
- 24 POUNDS, EQUIPPED WITH A FIFTH WHEEL ASSEMBLY WHICH CONFORMS WITH
- 25 MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY RULES PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE
- 26 POLICE PURSUANT TO THE MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ACT OF 1963, ACT
- 27 NO. 181 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1963, BEING SECTIONS 480.11 TO

- 1 480.21 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS; ATTACHED WITH A SEMITRAILER
- 2 DESIGNED FOR RECREATIONAL LIVING PURPOSES MAY TOW AN ADDITIONAL
- 3 TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 4 (A) THE ADDITIONAL TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER SHALL BE ATTACHED
- 5 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3). THE SAFETY CHAINS DESCRIBED IN
- 6 SUBSECTION (3) SHALL BE SECURELY ATTACHED AT THE EXTREME OUTER
- 7 EDGE OF THE ATTACHED TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER WITH A LOCKING
- 8 MECHANISM. THE TOWING VEHICLE HITCH SHALL BE OF SUBSTANTIAL
- 9 MATERIAL AND SHALL BE ATTACHED IN A PROPER AND SKILLFUL MANNER TO
- 10 THE FRAME OF THE TOWING VEHICLE:
- 11 (B) THE TOTAL LENGTH OF THE PICKUP TRUCK, SEMITRAILER
- 12 DESIGNED FOR RECREATIONAL LIVING PURPOSES, AND ADDITIONAL TRAILER
- 13 OR SEMITRAILER SHALL NOT EXCEED 59 FEET.
- 14 (C) THE GROSS WEIGHT OF THE ADDITIONAL TRAILER OR SEMI-
- 15 TRAILER TOWED OR DRAWN SHALL NOT EXCEED THE WEIGHT OF THE PICKUP
- 16 TRUCK OR THE WEIGHT OF THE SEMITRAILER.
- (6) -(4) A person who violates this section is responsible
- 18 for a civil infraction.
