## **HOUSE BILL No. 4371**

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Stabenow and Weeks and referred to the Committee on Towns and Counties.

A bill to amend section 21 of chapter IV of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of villages; to define their powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by villages; to define the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by villages subject thereto; and to validate prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by villages,"

being section 64.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

2	Sec. 21. The president and trustees shall -each receive
3	such sum as shall be fixed by ordinance for each regular meeting
4	of the village council by them respectively attended during their
5	term of office, such payment to be made out of the general fund
6	in the village treasury. Said officers RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS
7	PROVIDED BY ORDINANCE. THE ORDINANCE SHALL SPECIFY THE MANNER
8	AND METHOD THAT THE COMPENSATION IS DUE AND PAYABLE. THE PRESI-
9	DENT AND TRUSTEES shall receive no other compensation for serv-
10	ices performed for and on behalf of -said THE village during
11	their term of office. : Provided, That in no case shall such
12	president or any trustee receive compensation for any meetings
13	not actually attended. All other officers except where other
14	provision is made herein EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
15	ACT or by OTHER law regulating fees for services, ALL OTHER
16	OFFICERS shall receive such compensation as the council shall
17	prescribe.
